

("PIC Wisconsin") by American Physicians Assurance Corporation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 611.72.

4. Various provisions of Wis. Stat. § 611.72 refer to the interests of the insureds of the identified insurance company, the interests of Wisconsin policyholders, and the public interest, as considerations by the Commissioner of Insurance in making a decision in this proceeding.

5. The Wisconsin Medical Society represents physicians who are insureds and policyholders of PIC Wisconsin. Many of the physician members of the Wisconsin Medical Society, and the Wisconsin Medical Society itself, are shareholders of PIC Wisconsin. The Wisconsin Medical Society has been directly involved in matters affecting the public interest of this state by, among other things, fostering and preserving a positive medical malpractice climate. It is in the interests of all the members of the Wisconsin Medical Society and all of the insureds, policyholders and shareholders of PIC Wisconsin to retain and preserve the positive medical malpractice climate in the state.

6. Though the Wisconsin Medical Society will not be asserting a position in support of, or in opposition to, the application, the Wisconsin Medical Society is in a unique position to provide information to the Commissioner of Insurance related to the medical malpractice climate in Wisconsin to ensure that the Commissioner of Insurance possesses all relevant information in reaching his decision in this proceeding.
